Donna Lynn Antonucci, MD, FAAP is an Affiliate of the Department of Pediatrics of the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia and is part of the Community Medical Staff at St. Christopher's Hospital for Children. She is a practicing neurodevelopmental pediatrician in suburban Philadelphia.
