

## **Dr. Robert Neilson Daly**

Dr. Daly is an experienced professional with over 22 years in the Pharmaceutical and Biotech industry. He graduated from the Medical College of Pennsylvania with a doctorate in cardiovascular pharmacology. He also holds a Masters Degree from Drexel University where he studied aging and molecular genetics. In addition, Dr. Daly attended the Harvard University Business School of Executive Education.

Much of Dr. Daly's career has been devoted to cardiovascular clinical research. He has directed programs in all phases of development, with an emphasis in Phase 2 and Phase 3 programs for registration. He has run a Phase IV department and been the clinical authority for investigator initiated studies. He is currently concluding a global ST-segment elevation MI trial enrolling over 1800 patients in 15 countries. His experience includes running large international trials for a variety of therapeutic agents directed toward patients with myocardial infarction, acute coronary syndrome, lipid disorders and numerous trials for factor Xa inhibitors, antihypertensive agents as well as many others. In addition to his extensive cardiovascular experience he has also directed clinical programs for development in several other therapeutic areas including infectious disease, women's health, GI and psychiatry.

Dr. Daly has a notable publication and presentation track record. He has been an invited faculty member to a host of scientific organizations including the Beaver Creek Cardiovascular Conference, the Antithrombotic Trialists in Oxford, UK, the Drug Information Association and the Pharmaceutical Research and Manufacturing Association. He has presented at numerous scientific conferences including the American Heart Association, The American College of Cardiology and the European Society of Cardiology. Dr. Daly has presented on many occasions to the FDA in support of clinical programs. He also maintains strong ties to the academic community having held academic positions at several universities including at the Medical College of Pennsylvania, Drexel University, Holy Family University and Cabrini College. He has served as a member of the Alumni/ae Board of the Medical College and as a member of the Board of Trustees for the Trust Fund of the Alumnae/i Association of WMC/MCP.
